The Johnson County Fire Protection District is now accepting applications for the position of Full-time Fire Captain. The starting wage is \$15.25 per hour (non-exempt). The District provides a benefit plan including employer paid health, vision and dental coverage for the employee along with paid leave, retirement plan and other miscellaneous benefits. The Full-time Captain's primary work schedule will be 9 hour shifts, Monday – Friday.

Applicants must be 18 or older at the time of application, must possess a High School Diploma or GED, Firefighter I & II (IFSAC or ProBoard), possess a driver's license valid in the State of Missouri, have four years' service with the District or possess combinations of experience and training that would likely provide the required knowledge and abilities which may be considered and meet other qualifications and abilities as outlined by the District in the detailed job description.
